- Selma Unified serves National School Lunch, Breakfast and Supper Program Daily.
- Our District is Free Under the Community Eligibility Program (CEP) All meals are Free and no money is collected
- At Selma High and Abraham Lincoln Middle School we have Snack Bars where students can buy Approved Nutritious Snacks. Money is needed for those purchases. The snack bars are open daily during second chance breakfast and lunch
- We offer various choices at both Elementary and Secondary hot and cold
- We serve 8000 meals daily

1. Are meals free?

Yes. Under The Community Eligibility Program (CEP) all meals are free.
