The Wildland Firefighting course is designed to give students all the certificates, classroom, and field experience to apply for Firefighting jobs with the US Forest Service. After completion of this 48 hours course, you will earn the following NWCG (National Wildland Fire Coordinating Group) certificates:

S-190 - Introduction to Wildland Fire Behavior

S-130 - Firefighter Training

L-180 - Human Factors in the Wildland Fire Service

i100 - Introduction to the Incident Command System

i700 - Introduction to the National Incident Management System

These certificates meet the basic wildland firefighter training standards for all the Federal Wildland Fire Agencies.

*The program will provide helmets, safety glasses, gloves, and ear plugs.
Students must provide their own workboots.*
