

SELMA UNIFIED SEEKS TO FILL TRUSTEE VACANCY

The Selma Unified School District's Board of Education is saddened to announce the passing of Trustee Mark Falcon, and is subsequently seeking to fill its current vacancy for Trustee Area #1. The provisionally appointed member will complete the term through November 2020. Any local citizen interested in submitting an application to fill this position must submit a completed application packet by **Monday, January 28, 2019** by close of business. (No late applications accepted).

Application packets may be picked up from the Selma Unified School District Office at 3036 Thompson Avenue, between the hours of **8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.** To be considered, applicants must meet the following qualifications:

1. 18 years of age or older.
2. A citizen of California.
3. A resident of the school district and trustee area for which you will represent.
4. A registered voter.
5. Not be legally disqualified from holding civil office. Any person who has been convicted of a felony involving the giving, accepting, or offering of a bribe, embezzlement or theft of public funds, extortion, perjury, or conspiracy to commit any such crime under California law or the law of another state, the United States of America or another country, is not eligible to be a candidate for office or elected as a Board member except when he/she has been granted a pardon in accordance with law (Education Code 35107; Elections Code 20).
